1. Project Finance Recap - Mr. Parks briefly discussed CVES capital project that is projected at 30 million dollars. Saranac would be responsible for 3.3 million and after BOCES aid, 1.1 million from the local share.
2. CVES Facilities Study - Mr. Parks passed around the building conditions study that highlighted areas of need for the CVES facilities.
3. Building Input - Each building addressed areas of need for the capital project:
a. High School - Ceiling tiles, faucet repairs, carpet mold in the high school math wing, the need for a digital studio and/or library redesign, and upgrading security.
b. Middle School - The need for more teaching space, aesthetics including lighting, bathrooms, lockers, and locker rooms, and completing the heating and cooling project.
c. Morrisonville Elementary - The need for more teaching space, parking lot redesign, addition of a safer entryway, library (maker space), adult restroom/handicap restroom, updating of lighting in the gym, and fixing the sub pump issues.
d. Saranac Elementary - larger cafeteria, gym upgrades such as lighting, wall mats, and bleachers, library rehab, parking lot rehab and redesign (need for more spaces and drainage), carpet elimination, and lockers.
e. Athletics - Elementary gym upgrades, gym floor surfaces refinished, enlarging fitness center (and making it available to the community), building a space for wrestling, outdoor facilities/ handicap parking, tennis courts (move and expand), high school gym skylights fixed from leaks, and the football field (visitor side small space).
f. Kitchen - Modernize cafeteria (?), ventilation in the cafeteria and kitchen, sound proofing, freezer at MES, and steamer needs replacing.
