pan lid and not in hot held product. Corrected during inspection.

Comments:

Comment: The facility has established standard operating procedures that ensure a safe food preparation setting. Temperature logs are maintained, the importance of time / temperature control is understood and routine cleaning is apparent. Inspector discussed "III Food Worker Policy" with Kitchen manager and the importance of not working with food when sick. Menu served on day of inspection included: Hamburgers, cheese, lettuce and tomatoes, baked beans, canned pears, yogurt and milk. Hamburgers are precooked and only require heating. Hot holding time is less than two hours and the food is placed on the serving line just prior to the arrival of the next wave of students. Preparing the lettuce and tomatoes involves washing, chopping and slicing which, requires barrier (gloves) when handling as a critical control point. Items checked during inspection included the following: accuracy of food probe thermometers, proper hot and cold holding, availability of handwashing in food preparation area, use of barrier (gloves) for handling "ready to eat" food, availbility and proper concentration of sanitizer for wiping cloths, proper sanitizing by dishwasher, proper food and equipment storage and general sanitation.
